- Evergreen Habitat for Humanity has begun a new housing repair program called 'A Brush with Kindness'.
- Habitat for Humanity's 'A Brush with Kindness' is a nation-wide program serving low-income homeowners who struggle to maintain the exterior of their homes.
- Habitat for Humanity's 'A Brush with Kindness' focuses on exterior home repair services such as painting, landscaping and weatherization.
- Groups of volunteers work to revitalize a home's exterior.
- Habitat for Humanity's A Brush with Kindness serves low-income homeowners who are selected based on need. Each family must have an income between 30 and 50 percent of the median. Families must own their home and have homeowner's insurance and commit to assisting with repairs.
- Habitat for Humanity's A Brush with Kindness uses volunteer labor and donated materials to make repairs on homes, helping low-income homeowners continue to live independently and securely in their homes.
- Habitat for Humanity's A Brush with Kindness is part of Habitat's Neighborhood Revitalization Initiative. This initiative is a holistic approach, assisting communities as well as families. It is designed to revitalize the appearance of the neighborhood, encourages connections within the community, and most importantly, help preserve affordable housing stock.
